No food or drink in the soft play studio

A responsible adult to be present at all times

Maximum of five children to one adult

No toys or sharp objects, including glasses and jewellery

Play may be limited to 90 minutes during busy times

Please report any accidents or injuries to a member of staff immediately

If you child is unwell, please save your play for another day and get well soon.
